

More about Kids' Mental Health

Get help from the Mental Health Advocacy Program for Kids (MHAP for Kids)

1. Get ready to call us:

Have this information:

- How to contact you
- Where you live
- Your child's situation
- Your child's insurance information
- How many people are in your household
- Your income

2. When you are ready:

Call 617-275-2919 or 855-218-3965 (toll-free)

- Leave a message with your name, address, and phone number or email
- Describe the problem you have

If you can't call, fill out our intake form <u>here</u>.

3. What's next:

A paralegal from HLA will contact you. They will call you to talk about your problem.

- Next, HLA will decide if we can take your case.
- We will contact you to let you know if we can help.
- If HLA can't take your case, we will try to help you find an organization or resource that can help.

Who can HLA help?

To get help from HLA:

- 1. Your child needs to have a mental health illness or diagnosis.
- 2. You need to live in Massachusetts.
- 3. You need to meet **one** of our income requirements. **If you are not sure, call us anyway.** In 2024, this means:

For a family of 1, less than \$45,180 per year For a family of 2, less than \$61,320 per year For a family of 3, less than \$77,460 per year For a family of 4, less than \$93,600 per year For a family of 5, less than \$109,740 per year And so on...

OR

Have health care expenses or debt that are more than you can pay
